Commitment to Privacy

The District Administration of College Station ISD is committed to providing access to services and information online in a manner that respects and protects your privacy. This statement describes our information collection practices and explains how we use and protect your personal information through the use of the Survey service located at survey.csisd.org.

Providing survey responses is voluntary. You can always choose not to provide an answer to any given survey question (especially those requesting your personal information or data). However, sometimes this will prevent you from completing a survey if the creator has marked that question as requiring an answer.

Scope

This statement applies only to information collected by survey.csisd.org.

What we collect and why

When you respond to surveys hosted by College Station ISD, we collect information relating to you and your use of this service from a variety of sources. These are listed below.

Your login information.

Login information is used to determine whether or not you are authorized to use specific services. Your login information is not stored.

Personally identifiable information that you provide voluntarily.

This may include information such as campus(es) attended, employment and family demographics. This information is used to provide the district with information to assist in making decisions.

Auto-collected information (web logs)

Our web server automatically recognizes the Internet domain and IP address from which you accessed our web site, the date and time of your visit, and the pages you visited on our site, as well as information automatically forwarded by your browser. This information is used to help us understand aggregate uses of our site, track usage trends, and improve our services. Web logs may also be used for system problem monitoring and maintenance. This information is retained on a temporary basis, accessed only by the system developer(s) and system administrator(s) and then deleted completely from our systems.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that many web sites transfer to users' hard drives to enable the site to deliver personalized services or to provide persistent authentication. The information contained

in a cookie typically includes information collected automatically by the web server and/or information provided voluntarily by the user. The user controls, via the computer's operating system, whether cookies will be accepted and, if so, how they will be handled (for example, deleted or saved). Our web site uses cookie technology. If the user blocks cookies, however, this will negatively affect the functionality of this site. The cookies used by this web site prevent abuse of the system (Spamming), allow users to "save" and "continue" surveys, and do not track a user's browser history.

You can choose to remove or disable cookies via your browser. Please refer to your web browser's configuration documentation to learn how to do this. Doing this may adversely impact your ability to use this service. Enabling cookies ensures a smoother experience when using this service. By using this website and service as described in this privacy policy, you expressly consent to the use of cookies as described in this policy.

Usage Data

We collect usage data about you whenever you interact with our services. This may include which webpages you visit, what you click on, when you performed those actions, and so on. Additionally, as with most modern websites today, our web servers keep log files that record data each time a device accesses those servers. The log files contain data about the nature of each access, including originating IP address. We do not link usage data information to your survey responses.

Device data

We collect data from the device and application you use to access our service, such as your IP address and browser type. We may also infer your geographic location based upon your IP address. Your IP address will be linked to your survey responses in these log files, but the information will not be displayed with your survey responses.

Referral data

We may record information about the source that referred you to a survey.

Your email address

If a survey uses an email invitation collector to send you a survey invitation email, we collect your email address when it is provided. We will not use this information to send you email except at the direction of the survey creator. The emails we send on behalf of the survey creator appear to come from the survey creator's email address.

Security

We are committed to ensuring the security of your information. We have put in place reasonable physical, technical, and administrative safeguards designed to prevent unauthorized access to, or use of, the information collected online. We collect and store data from surveys on a local server

locked in the College Station ISD district administration data center, in the United States. You can view the address of this location by visiting the College Station ISD home page. We are committed to handling your personal information with integrity and care. Our information systems infrastructure is owned and managed by College Station ISD and their employees. Our data center is secured with entry requirements and an alarm system. Entry requirements include passcards and limited key locks. All passcard entry is in a log file. Our data center has temperature controls which are continuously monitored by CSISD Technology administration staff. Smoke and fire detection and response systems are in place. However, regardless of the security protections and precautions we undertake, there is always a risk that information provided may be viewed and used by unauthorized third parties as a result of collecting and transmitting your data through the internet. Despite best efforts, no method of transmission over the internet and no method of electronic storage is perfectly secure. We cannot guarantee absolute security. However, if CSISD Technology Systems team learns of a security breach, we will notify affected users so they may take appropriate steps. Our breach notifications procedure are consistent with our obligations under state and federal laws as well as industry rules and standards we adhere to. Notification procedures include providing email notices or posting a notice on our website. The only information shared with the survey creators of this site are the responses you provide.

Sharing your information

We will not share your information with third parties except as required by law.

Children under 13

This web site is intended for use by people aged 13 or older. If you are under 13, please do not send any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, or email address. In the event that we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under age 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information as quickly as possible.
